Fieldwork Safety Training

This 4-hour classroom based session is split between planning on paper and practical sessions to look at actively applying this paperwork:

Paperwork: We will look at the main documents central to expedition fieldwork plans - the Risk Assessment and the Crisis Management Plan.

Practice: Risk assessments, crisis management plans etc are too often seen as a necessary evils, which take time to produce. Using a combination of discussions and practical sessions we look at real life examples of why the paperwork is important and how it can be actively applied and adapted in the field.
